## Area Attractions

### Downhill Skiing

Kettle Bowl Ski Hill                      This is a small community run hill with ropes tows only, open on weekends  
Very inexpensive (\$5) close by take 55 south to Hwy 52 and West four miles.

Iron Mountain Ski Area                      Approximately 1 ½ hours North in Iron Mountain

Pine Mountain Ski Area                      Also about 1 ½ hours North

### Cross Country Skiing

See options in the trail section. Lakewood is a favorite not too far away and very scenic!

### Snowmobiling, ATV's, Canoe Trips, Hiking

### Old Growth Forest

### LumberJack Steam Train and Museum

Ride a steam train into the forest! See how logging was done in the past. Not far away in Laona June/August

### Fishing

Of course you can fish on Pickerel and Crane lakes. The 14' fishing boat will go through the channel from Pickerel to Crane Lake. Ice Fishing is popular also.
